



Iain Scott Matthew

Iain Scott Matthew is a Discalced Carmelite friar and priest of the Anglo-Hibernian Province. He entered the Discalced Carmelites in 1978. Since 2014 he has been teaching at the Teresianum Pontifical Faculty of Spirituality in Rome. Fr Matthew completed his doctorate, on the consciousness of Christ and the writings of St John of the Cross, under Professor Edward Yarnold SJ and Professor Rowan Williams at the University of Oxford in 1991. As part of that work he was permitted to attend in 1988-1989 the course on St John of the Cross at the Centro Internacional Teresiano-Sanjuanista (CITeS), Avila. There, the teaching of P. Maximiliano Herraiz and of P. Federico Ruiz was especially influential. Since then he has been involved in parish ministry, youth chaplaincy, and retreat ministry, in Australia, Ireland, Britain and Venezuela. He has taught brief courses on St John of the Cross at CITeS. He is the author of articles on themes of Carmelite spirituality, and of two small books on St John of the Cross.
