She is a doctoral graduate of the Divinity School of the University of Cambridge and she holds the STL and STD degrees from the Pontifical Lateran University as well as primary degrees in law, philosophy and political science. From 2001-2017 she was the Dean of the St. John II Institute for Marriage and Family (Melbourne) and from 2014-2019 she was a member of the 9th International Theological Commission. She is a member of the editorial board of the English language edition of *Communio: International Catholic Review* and the author of 7 books and editor of 3 collections of essays. Her latest book is *Beyond Kant and Nietzsche: The Munich Defence of Christian Humanism* (London: Bloomsbury, 2021). In 2010 she was awarded the Officer's Cross in the Order of Merit of the Republic of Poland and in 2020 was awarded the Ratzinger Prize for Theology
